What did you feel when you didn't know a specific date when you were going to return?

Well that was the hardest part in my life because I was thinking about my daughters because they were left behind thinking about my wife she was suffering a lot. How am I going to find the stuff I felt there who is going to take care of them?

What did you do to handle your emotions?

Well 95% of the time I had to hide my emotions because my wife she was sensitive and she couldn't handle that so I pretty much hide everything.

When the time kept going by and not knowing a date how did you feel seeing time go by?

Every day was going by it felt like a part o f my life was going in the garbage. I was frustrated I was mad at the government of the USA. I was very upset they took that decision.

For all the time you spent their how did you help your family and how did you feel not being there for your family?

I feel really bad I knew my daughters needed us. Being outside father and mother I can only imagine how hard it was. I knew my daughters were strong. And the same time I was finding the positive. This made my family really strong and changed my life forever.

What did you think about your company how did you feel?

I was really concerned. A lot of people waiting for me to fail and was very concerned about my company. But I had good connection with my biggest client and he made sure I will have my job back when I returned.

How did you feel that family members and co workers are waiting for you to fail?

I was very devastated because you think that no one will thing against you. But its life and you have to fight it. What really upset me is that people were fighting with me and I wasn't there to defend myself. But what made me strong is when I came back. Sorry they lost I'm here.

Who or what was one of the thing that gave you faith that you were going to come back soon?

There is bad and good the good stuff and bad stuff. Lady from the US embassy she was my angel for 11 months. She kept me fighting she helped me fight and pretty much brought us back. Her name is Sandra ranyas she deserves my big thank you and I admire her she saw that things weren't fair for me and my family what was happening that time and she helped us at that time.

What was the reason for this event?

My ex lawyer committed fraud and no paper were submitted and court papers. But it wasn't me. He ended up going to jail. I left because I didn't want to break the law anymore. Gov saw I had nothing to do with the fraud the lawyer did.

Who helped you?

My cousin and his wife. They are good listeners and I went to church

What was the date you came back?

November 21st 2009

How did you feel when you received the news you could come back?

My lawyer told me the news and I cried like a baby because I hold it for 11 months, because my wife couldn't handle seeing me cry. It was the most beautiful day of my life.

How did you feel letting your family know?

I felt the luckiest guy ion earth I don't have to lie anymore. I didn't have to tell them a date when I didn't know.
